12 Card Games

50 cards per pack

Word.Ch.

The suits (clubs, diamonds etc.) are represented by 'punctuation marks' and therefore these games can be played like traditional card games. Word.Ch. gives practice in use of initial consonants, blends, digraphs and endings as well as reinforcing + developing vocabulary, basic reading and spelling skills. This learning is further stimulated by a healthy sense of competition while allowing for continuous repetition without the element of boredom.

24 Board Games

There are 12 Snakes & Ladders and 12 alternative board games which also require a learning/recognition of geometric shapes. They are all played using dice like traditional board games. They are based on the same words as the card games and hence offer excellent variety to the learning experience. It is recommended to start with S&L and then alternate as deemed appropriate.

12 Assessments

Each 2-sided A4 assessment sheet (with 1 side lined for student use) can be photocopied. These can be used to assess word recognition/pronunciation and also as spelling tests. The assessment indicates when one should progress to the next level and can also be used for revision. They are invaluable for record keeping.
